
GOOD CHOICE OR POOR CHOICE MAZE SAMPLE

DIRECTIONS:

Begin by reviewing what is a good choice and what is a poor choice. Ask the students how they feel when they make a poor choice and how others feel when they make a poor choice. Next ask them to say how they feel when they make a good choice and how others feel when they make a good choice. When completing the maze, the students will pause when they get to a picture or word square, and state whether the behavior is a good choice or a poor choice. There are color versions of the maze included which would be great to laminate and use a dry erase marker with to re-use them. 
